Subject: Grant of Peak Load Exemption to General Industrial consumers.

To avoid delay in grant on Peak Load Exemption to General LS consumers, it is intimated that general industrial consumers who had applied for Peak Load Exemption above 100 KW in this office or in the office of respective Chief Engineer/DS, are allowed to use Peak Load Exemption w.e.f 1.10.10 onwards up to 31.5.11 as per their requirement (maximum up to 90% sanctioned contract demand). Sanction letters are being issued separately.

The consumers seeking peak Load Exemption above 100 KW, who have not already applied to this office should apply immediately through E-mail, fax or post directly to this office.

According to availability of power various power regulatory measures/relaxations were made applicable on industrial consumers. All industrial consumers were relaxed from observing weekly off day from 1.8.10 to 2.8.10. Thereafter from 3.8.10 to 10.8.10 one weekly off day was imposed on General Industrial consumers and 2 weekly off days were imposed on Arc/Induction and Rolling mill consumers vide this office telephone message dated 2.8.10 (Flag-A). Thereafter 3 weekly off days on Arc/Induction and Rolling mill consumers and 2 weekly off days on General Industrial consumers and PLHRs of 24 hours were imposed on continuous process industrial consumers w.e.f 10.8.10 vide this office telephone message no. 306/11 dated 10.8.10 (Flag-B). As these power regulatory measures were imposed instantaneously with immediate effect and consumers have not given time to note and follow these instructions properly, these instructions were withdrawn later on vide this office telephone message no. 465/11 dated 13.8.10 (Flag-C). Accordingly these power regulatory measures are not to be included in the consolidated PR circular 9/2010 to be issued.

Relaxations from observing weekly off day were given from 11.8.10 to 13.8.10 and 15.8.10 vide this office telephone message no. 378 dated 11.8.10 (Flag-D) and 505 dated 15.8.10 (Flag-E). But in between one weekly off day on General Industrial consumers and 2 weekly off days on Arc/Induction and Rolling mill consumers were imposed for 14.8.10, vide this office telephone message no. 476 dated 13.8.10 (Flag-F). Due to short period for noting and follow the instructions by the consumers it is proposed that dated 14.8.10 may also be treated as relaxation day as weekly off day were relaxed from 11.8.10 to 13.8.10 and 15.8.10. Thus one weekly off day on general industrial consumers and two days on Arc/Induction furnace and Rolling mill consumers remained applicable w.e.f 16.8.10 to 17.8.10 as all industrial consumers were again relaxed from observing weekly off days w.e.f 18.8.10 vide this office telephone msg no. 581 dated 18.8.10 (Flag-G).

Again One weekly off day on General Industrial consumers and 2 weekly off days on Arc/Induction and Rolling mill consumers were imposed vide this office telephone msg no. 727/11 dated 30.8.10 w.e.f 31.8.10 onwards (Flag-H).

As the power regulatory measures were imposed to get relief for system and not to penalize the consumers and keeping in view short period given to consumers to note and follow the instructions, it is proposed that weekly off day imposed wef 3.8.10 and 31.8.10 may be made effective w.e.f. 4.8.10 and 1.9.10 respectively.

All industrial consumers are at presently have been relaxed from observing weekly off day w.e.f 4.9.10 onwards due to wide spread rain in the region.

Case is therefore put up for approval of Director/D accordingly to delete the 14.8.10 from observing power regulatory measures and make power regulatory measures imposed w.e.f 3.8.10 and 31.8.10, effective from 4.8.10 and 1.9.10 respectively so that a consolidated circular may be issued please. PR circular 9/2010 has been prepared accordingly and attached below for approval please.
